Consideration of Online NOC applications

Case no. 380

(Shri Sanjeev Jain, B-2/21, Safdurjung Enclave, New Delhi)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18.00 mtrs (including mummy parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at B-2/21, Safdurjung Enclave, New Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=FF=SF=TF=125.39 sqm and Basement = 125.39 sqm with depth=3.20 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of Competent Authority, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.



Case no. 381

(Smt. Santosh Malik and Shri Pankaj Malik, 11/3, Sarvapriya Vihar, New Delhi)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18.00 mtrs (including mummy parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at 11/3, Sarvapriya Vihar, New Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=FF=SF=TF=95.28 sqm and Basement = 95.28 sqm with depth=2.90 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of Competent Authority, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.

Case no. 382

(Shri Mukul Verma, G-10, Hauz Khas Enclave, New Delhi)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18.00 mtrs (including mummy parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at Plot no. 10, Block no. G, Hauz Khas Enclave, New Delhi; with floor area of GF=FF=125.24 sqm, SF=TF=123.62 sqm and Basement = 109.58 sqm with depth=2.10 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of Competent Authority, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.

Case no. 383

(Mrs. Anila Chatrath, F-12, Nizamuddin West, New Delhi)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18.00 mtrs (including mummy parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at Plot no. 12, Block no. F, Nizamuddin West, New Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=FF=SF=TF=125.34 sqm and Basement = 125.34 sqm with depth= 2.85 mtrs. The recommendation is in accordance with the Heritage Bye Laws of Humayun's Tomb-Sundar Nursery- Batashewala group of monuments which was laid in both the houses of Parliament on 09.07.2019(Rajya Sabha) and on 22.07.2019 (Lok Sabha). The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of Competent Authority, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.



Case no. 384

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18.00 mtrs (including mummy parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at E-33, Hauz Khas Enclave Market, New Delhi; with floor area of GF=FF=SF=TF=125.34 sqm and Basement = 125.34 sqm with depth= 3.15 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of Competent Authority, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building. The earlier NOC stands cancel.
